

Overview of the Super-Y Program



- Super-Y teams are a member of the United Soccer League (USL) Super-Y League (SYL)
- NVSC participates in the SYL Mid-Atlantic Conference
- Clubs from across the U.S. compete to place in the SYL National Finals tournament in December
- Provides opportunity for continued player development over the summer months
- Great preparation for the 2024-2025 regular club season (rising age groups)
- Allows players to experience variety of teammates and coaches







OVERVIEW OF NVSC PROGRAM



- NVSC is planning to field teams in age groups from U11 through U19; however, team formation will be contingent on tryout numbers in each of the age and gender groups. (Note that age groups may be combined.)
- NVSC will be hosting tryouts Jan 20 and 27; backup dates will be in February and are currently TBD
- Super-Y tryouts are open to all appropriately aged players, whether registered with NVSC or not.
- Teams will be formed and registered by mid-February.
- Practices will be 2x per week, starting in June.
- Matches will start in Mid-June through the end of July
 - Some may extend into the first weekend of August.
- Hellwig Park is our home park for training and matches.





WHY PLAY SUPER-Y



- Super-Y is a great avenue to continue player development; the NVSC objective is to encourage participation in Super-Y as part of NVSC's year around program.
- Super-Y offers an opportunity for players, and teams, to prepare for the Fall; to get a jump start on the competition as the Fall season kicks off.
- Super-Y offers a strong competitive environment over the summer for players to further hone their skills.
- Opportunity to play in the National Finals if you win your Division during the season.



WHO CAN PLAY?



Who? NVSC Super-Y teams are open to all ageappropriate, travel and recreational boys and girls, no matter the regular season club affiliation

Age Groups – The follow age groups will be provided to membership for the 2024 Season:

- Boys U11 (2014), U12 (2013), U13 (2012), U14 (2011), U15 (2010), U16 (2009), U17 (2008), U18/19 (2007 & 2006)
- Girls U11 (2014), U12 (2013), U13 (2012), U14 (2011), U15 (2010), U16 (2009), U17/19 (2008, 2007, & 2006)
 Only three (3) overage players allowed for U18/19B and U17/19G Groups (birth year 2005)

•U11 (2014) teams will not be eligible to attend Super-Y Finals









- U11-U12 : (16) player gameday roster
 - Up to 18 players may be offered roster spots
- U13-U19 : (18) player gameday roster
 - Up to 20 players may be offered roster spots
- Teams must have registered players for Super-Y rosters; no guest players.



TRYOUT PROCESS



- Players must be registered in the NVSC SuperY Tryout program to be eligible to receive an invite to a SuperY team.
- Registration can be accomplished by going to the NVSC Website, click on the SuperY Link, then click to REGISTER.
- Once registered, the player needs to attend tryouts (see next slide for dates and times).
 - If players have a conflict with tryouts, they should reach out to the NVSC SuperY info email; alternative dates may be available to train with NVSC winter training events.
- Once a player receives an invite, the invite must be accepted, and the deposit paid to secure a roster spot. Only after accepting and paying the deposit is a player considered fully registered.


NATIONAL FINALS

Home Fields

Hellwig Park premium turf fields in central Prince William County



- Registered/rostered player fee: \$550
 - \$200 of which is non-refundable deposit to register
 - NOTE: For NVSC rostered travel players 2024-2025, a \$100 credit will be applied toward / credited to your 2024-2025 travel fees
- Uniforms: NVSC will provide Blue jersey/White jersey
 - Blue Shorts and socks are responsibility of the player



- Do I need to attend all tryouts? It is best if you can attend all of the tryout sessions; however, its understood there may be conflicts. Please let us know if you have a conflict to work around.
- What if I cannot attend the tryout dates? NVSC is conducting Age Group/Team Training throughout the winter and can work through conflicts. Contact us for dates and times.
- When will I find out about making the team? Within 72 hours after the tryout on the 27th, NVSC will be in contact. Players may be contacted after the tryout on the 20th. An invite will be sent out, inviting you to register for the team. To complete registration, you must accept the invitation and go through the registration process.
- When I register, what is required? Each player will be required to make a \$200 deposit to register. Payments must be completed by the start of training (June 1st), or other arrangements made.
- Can a player "play up" an age group? Yes with TDOC approval. For example, 2015 birth years may be considered for the U11/2014 team. All other requests will be case by case basis dependent on roster numbers of the appropriate age group team and advanced qualities to "play up".
- Who is on the coaching staff? The coaching staff is still being determined at this time to provide the best match with the team.
- Is there cross-over between SuperY and PRO23 Registration? SuperY and PRO23 are separate programs run by separate soccer organizations; each having their own fees. If you want to play in both, you must register and tryout for each program with NVSC.
