
Northern Virginia Soccer Club strives to be the most professional, "Player Development-First" club in the region.

Coaches and staff put the players' improvement over match results. We follow the four pillars of development,

Technical, Tactical, Physical, and Psychological.

### **NVSC Vision**

- Player development has been and will be the focus for NVSC.
- Our development process focuses on the Pillars of Development noted earlier, building on the success of the prior year of training and play.
- In support of this initiative, NVSC is transitioning to a program to recognize player development and conduct ID sessions moving forward, with developmental milestones and events.
- This allows a clear pathway and measuring tool for player development and provides parents with a clear vision of how their player can develop toward their end goals.



### **NVSC League Play for 2024 - 2025**

- NVSC is committed to Leagues that offer commitment to player development and advancement opportunities:
  - U13 U19: National Capital Soccer League (NCSL)
  - U11 U12: National Capital Soccer League (NCSL)
  - U09 U10: National Capital Soccer League (NCSL)
  - U11 U19 Alternate: USYS National League, South Atlantic Conference (Selected teams may play in both EDP and NCSL, depending on competitive level of team).

NVSC continues to monitor opportunities for our players in terms of leagues and tournaments to provide appropriate competitive levels

## Overview of NVSC 2024 - 2025 Program

#### **Summer Technical Training:**

 NVSC will be hosting age group technical training in June, prior to team training which starts the first week in August. This period of training is primarily focused on individual skills and small sided activities. Scrimmages will be worked into the sessions as appropriate for the training.

#### (Enhanced) Fitness-Agility-Speed-Technique (eFAST):

The goal of eFAST is to promote fitness that incorporates soccer footwork and technique. We have expanded the program to cover all age groups: U9 – U19. This program is included in the fees and is conducted 2x per year, during the pre-season (August and March). This effort is being led by Aaron Etienne coupled with staff support.

#### **Training Format:**

• Training will be 3 times per week for all teams during match play months. The approach is to focus 2 times per week on team training with a 3<sup>rd</sup> session for specialized topics (such as eFAST) as determined by the Technical Staff.

### Overview of NVSC 2024 – 2025 Program (continued)

### **League Play:**

Teams will be registered to play in NCSL; higher competitive teams may be invited to play in USYS EDP.

#### **Tournaments:**

All NVSC teams are eligible for play in NVSC-sponsored tournaments, with the prerequisite that each team,
playing or not-playing, must provide volunteers to support and execute the tournaments. Tournaments are
chosen to be reflective of the team competitive level. Teams play in both NVSC tournaments as part of their
fees. NVSC includes non-NVSC paid tournaments/events as part of fees as well.

#### **NVSC Travel Player Scholarship:**

In 2021-2022, NVSC established an annual scholarship program for NVSC travel players. NVSC is committed
to selecting 1 male and 1 female graduating player to receive a \$500 NVSC scholarship for college;
applications will be provided in early Spring 2025 with the scholarship award in May 2025.

## Overview of NVSC 2024-2025 Program (continued)

#### **NVSC Adidas Uniform Package:**

All NVSC players for 2024 – 2025 will be required to wear the NVSC uniform. If you are a new player, you will be required to purchase a uniform; if you are an existing player, a uniform purchase is only needed if you have out grown or lost your uniform. The NVSC Team Kit includes game uniform of 2 jerseys, shorts, socks, a training uniform consisting of 1 jersey, shorts and socks. Recommended items are warmup and player travel bag (warmups and travel bags must be Adidas NVSC purchased through soccer.com if purchased).

#### Video:

• NVSC has been using TRACE for the past three years; however, NVSC is evaluating video alternatives for the 2024-2025 seasonal year.

#### **Communication - TeamSnap:**

After a successful club-wide use of TeamSnap over the past 3 years, NVSC will continue to use the
platform for team and manager communication, weather and schedule updates, and important travel
team-specific information.

## Overview of NVSC 2024-2025 Program (continued)

### **NVSC Senior Celebration Day:**

 Each Spring, NVSC sets aside a day to celebrate our student-athletes and recognize their accomplishments as they graduate.

### **International Travel Program:**

 NVSC has affiliated with Generation Adidas International (GAI)/InspireSport to offer NVSC teams the opportunity to go overseas for training and friendly play. Our targeted teams are U13 to U14; however, older teams may participate depending on their interest.

This summer, an NVSC girls 2010/2011 team is heading to England; August 2<sup>nd</sup> to August 11<sup>th</sup>.



## **Tournaments/Events Overview**

- NVSC Tournaments All teams participate; all teams volunteer.
  - Battlefield Tournament October
  - Hunt Country Fall Classic (HCFC) Tournament November
- Non-NVSC Hosted Tournaments/Events in the pool for consideration
  - USYS National League Play; USYS EDP/CCL Hosted Showcase (Feb); CCL College Showcase (Dec); Loudoun Showcase (Mar); Adidas National Cup (Feb); WAGS (Oct); Arlington (Feb/Mar); Alexandria ASIST (Mar); Stafford St. Patricks (Mar); and VSA Cannon Cup (May)Tournament(s)
  - State Cup and Presidents Cup
  - Tournament selected for participation by NVSC TDOC consistent with team competitive level
- Teams may consider attending "extra" tournaments at additional cost; to be discussed after team selections.

### ID Session/Tryout and "INVITE" Process

### The path for participation on an NVSC Travel Team is as follows:

- Register and Attend Tryouts. All players must register in the NVSC system. –
  If you have conflicts with attendance, contact Hans to let him know.
- Once Tryouts are complete, selected players will be provided an "INVITE" email from the club to join a team /age group. Goal is for the club to provide responses (INVITES) back to players within 48 hours after the last tryout for that age group.
- The player/parent must either ACCEPT or DECLINE the invitation. Non-responses to the club after 48 hours are assumed to be declined. The time period allows the club the opportunity to fill that roster slot with another player.
- Accepting the invite to join NVSC will require a non-refundable deposit of \$200.

- If a parent or guardian decides to remove their player from the club, or if a player is dismissed due conduct violations, no refunds will be issued.
- Player fees are non-refundable.
