COVID-Related Safety Protocols
Spectator Update

Due to Governor Northam's recent Executive Order, the Hunt Country Fall Classic has adjusted our COVID Safety Protocols in order to comply. The following regulations will be enforced at all HCFC Match Fields:

- All players and coaches MUST complete a health check before they arrive at the field for each game.
- Coaches are to wear masks at all times.
- When players are on the sideline and not playing, they need to have masks on and maintain a 10 foot distance.
- Each team is allowed 12 spectators to attend per game, this does not have to be the same 12 each game.
- All 24 spectators will be required to wear a mask at all times.
- Spectators will be required to be behind or the spectator line or at least 10 feet from the field, whichever is further.
- If at any point the game exceeds the 24 spectators, the game will be stopped until we are back in compliance with the governor's orders.
- If the game is stopped due to excessive spectators then the clock will continue to run.
- Teams may choose one (1) representative to stream or record the game for the parents unable to attend. This person counts towards the 12 spectators for a team. FCSC and NVSC do not take any responsibility for this.
- The site coordinator tent will be marked with a 6 foot line. Please refrain from crossing that line for any reason. (not sure this is needed)

Along with these guidelines, we will also be enforcing the regulations that we had previously posted on the tournament website.
