Current and Near-Term Activities

- **Currently – Age Group training weekdays until July 22.**
 - This has included the adoption of a fitness portion.
- **Coaches meeting was held last week; team meetings will start this coming week.**
- **Managers for teams have been/are being recruited.**
- **Training starts the first week of August**
 - **First week is Pre-season Camp (includes skill, technique and fitness test)**
 - **After first week we get into Team Training.**
 - **eFast (enhanced Fitness – Agility – Speed – Technique) kicks off in early August**
- **Club-to-club scrimmages are being scheduled for August – schedules TBD.**
- **Matches start the latter part of August for some; September for most team.**
- **CCL Kwik Goal ScrimmageFest August 27-28 for U8 – U12 at Hellwig Park.**

Communications

- **Club communication to Travel teams/members is via email from Demosphere or from TeamSnap**
 - **Each team has their own TeamSnap account; accounts are being populated with the rosters and contact information.**
 - **Schedules for practices, scrimmages, matches, tournaments will be loaded into the accounts**
 - **Both Team and Club messages are broadcast over TeamSnap.**
 - **Please check your registration account in Demosphere to ensure that the email you want to use is current.**
 - **If you have unsubscribed, then you will not be able to receive emails.**
 - **If you have changed emails, please update.**
 - **There is also the possibility of it going to SPAM.**

Schedules

- **August training schedules are planned to be released later this week.**
 - Schedules are laid out to allow for similar age groups to work together to build on techniques and tactics
- **Game schedules will be released dependent on the league; we will be working with the leagues to deconflict coaches that have multiple teams – date is TBD. NVSC teams are playing in the following leagues:**
 - USYS
 - CCL DMV Premier
 - CCL Super League
 - CCL NextGen

Tournaments

- **Tournament assignments for each team are being worked and will be completed by the end of July**
 - **Tournaments for each team are selected by the club staff based on team competitive levels.**
- **NVSC hosts two tournaments – all NVSC teams are expected to participate via playing in and helping execute the tournaments.**
 - **Battlefield – Columbus Day - October**
 - **Hunt Country Fall Classic - November**
- **For U8 – U12 – CCL ScrimmageFests are included in the fees; Note: first of which is in August, at Hellwig Park.**

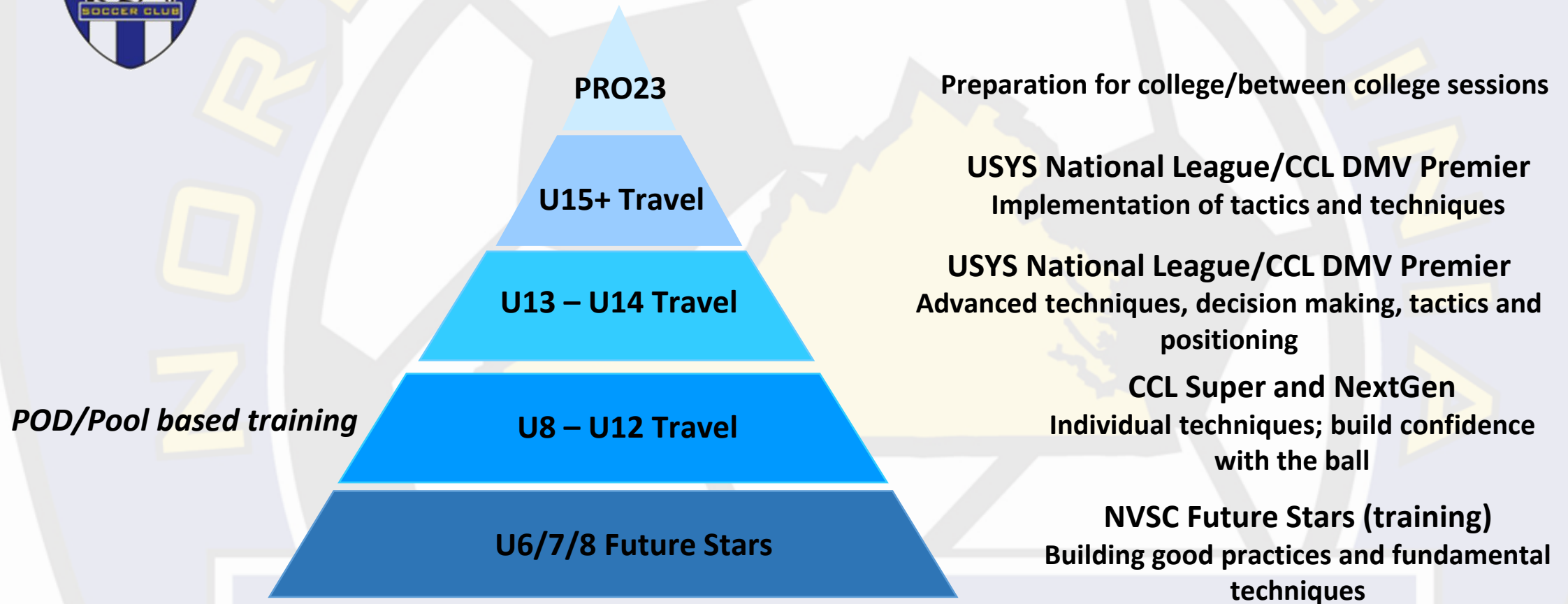
NVSC Player Objective
